

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Supplemental Police Account (SPA) Fourth Quarterly Report (October through December 2018).

Recommendation for Council action:

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on May 22, 2019, the Public Safety Committee considered a Board of Police Commissioners (BOPC) report (dated March 26, 2019, attached to the Council file) relative to the SPA Fourth Quarterly Report (October through December 2018). During this reporting period, there were 18 SPA expenditures in which drugs or assets were seized. These expenditures resulted in 25 arrests and the seizure of \$23,866.00 in United States currency. Also seized were 12,272.12 grams of narcotics.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to note and file the recommendations in the BOPC report. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
