Summary:

On June 20, 2018, your Committee considered a May 21, 2018 Adopted Budget Recommendation (ABR) relative to the feasibility of creating an Ordinance requiring successor contractors and their subcontractors to hire candidates from the TLH Program if a contract is terminated.
