

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance amending Sections 8.325 and 8.325.2 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to delegate oversight of the Los Angeles County Safe, Clean Neighborhood Parks and Beaches Protection Measure of 2016 (Measure A) to the L.A. for Kids Steering Committee.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Subsection (e) of Section 8.325 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

(e) the City's program for use of funds from the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002 (Proposition 40);

Sec. 2. New Subsections (f) and (g) are added to Section 8.325 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to read as follows:

(f) the Vermont/Western Station Neighborhood Area Specific Plan Parks First Program; and

(g) the City's program for use of funds from the Los Angeles County Safe, Clean Neighborhood Parks and Beaches Protection Measure of 2016 (Measure A).

Sec 3. Subsection (b) of Section 8.325.2 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

(b) Administer the use and expenditure of funds from Propositions A, A-II, 40, 12, and Measure A, including overseeing a competitive grant process for use of Roberti-z'Berg-Harris block grants and Murray Hayden Urban Parks grants, which process shall be substantially similar to the competitive process for use of Proposition K funds, and any other competitive grant processes established by the City Council for programs administered by the Steering Committee.

Sec 4. Subsection (g)(1) of Section 8.325.2 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

(1) Monitoring of the status of projects, costs, and schedules of projects funded by Propositions K, A, A-II, 12, 40, and Measure A, in the participating City departments and commissions.

Sec. 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
