

ARTS, ENTERTAINMENT, PARKS AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the status of the Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) systems at City parks and recreation facilities.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to (Huizar - O'Farrell):

1. INSTRUCT the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), to report on the following:
 - a. Status of the HVAC systems at City parks and recreation centers.
 - b. Information about the age of existing systems, frequency of repairs at each facility, the cost of upgrading the facilities to modern systems, and the existing staff resources dedicated to fixing HVAC systems.

2. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) to report on the staffing and financial resources, as well as an implementation plan, needed in order to ensure that all City recreation centers have modern and functioning HVAC systems.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At the meeting held August 22, 2018, your Arts, Entertainment, Parks and River Committee considered Motion (Huizar - O'Farrell) relative to the status of the HVAC systems in City facilities. The Motion attached to the Council file, includes some background on the matter.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion with the amendments as reflected above. This matter is now forwarded to the City Council for its consideration.
