HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to evaluating the property at 7621 Canoga Avenue as a crisis and bridge housing facility.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Harris-Dawson):

- 1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority, and any other affected City stakeholders, to work with the Los Angeles County to evaluate the property at 7621 Canoga Avenue to determine if the property is suitable for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility.
- INSTRUCT the City Homeless Coordinator, if the property is determined to be suitable for development as a crisis and bridge housing facility, to coordinate with the Los Angeles County to identify funds for operations at the site, including, but not limited to County Measure H revenue.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

## Summary:

At a regular meeting held on September 5, 2018, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield - Harris-Dawson) regarding the property at 7621 Canoga Avenue as a crisis and bridge housing facility.
