

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to maintenance of the City's unimproved median islands.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. TRANSFER \$750,000 from Fiscal Year 2019-20 Measure M Local Return Fund - Unimproved Median Island Maintenance, Fund No. 59C/94, Account No. TBD, to the following accounts at the Bureau of Street Services (BSS), Fund No. 100/86, as follows:

- 2. AUTHORIZE the BSS to make any technical corrections required to effectuate the actions as found in the BSS report dated June 13, 2019, attached to the Council file.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 19, 2019, your Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered said BSS report relative to maintenance of the City's unimproved median islands. The BSS reports that there are two different classes of median islands within the public right of way; improved and unimproved. Improved median islands have an irrigation system; currently BSS maintains more than 10 million square feet of improved median islands using contractors. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the Board's recommendations, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
