

TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to recommendations and strategy for developing the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) Transportation Management Organization (TMO).

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin – Blumenfield):

DIRECT the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) to report in 90 days on a strategy for developing an LAX TMO to serve employers and employees engaged in the operations, management and construction at LAX.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On September 25, 2018, Council considered Motion (Bonin – Blumenfield) relative to developing an LAX TMO to serve employers and employees engaged in the operations, management, and construction at LAX. Motion states that with over 50,000 jobs located in and around the airport, LAWA needs a holistic approach to mobility management that reaches employees, tenants, contractors, and nearby employers. A TMO is an association formed to identify transportation management and transit options in a specific region and develop policies and programs to encourage alternative forms of transportation, such as public transit, carpooling, vanpooling, bicycling, and walking; significantly reducing traffic congestion and improving air quality. Such an organization can serve all employers involved in the operation and management of the airport, including major airlines, airline support companies, freight operators, food service and terminal workers, as well as LAWA management, staff, and contractors.

Motion recommends that Council instruct LAWA to report with recommendations for developing a TMO for LAX. Council referred Motion to the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee for consideration.

At its special meeting held October 30, 2018, the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee recommended that Council approve Motion.
