**DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 63.44.N OF THE LOS ANGELES
MUNICIPAL CODE TO ALLOW RIDING OF NON-MOTORIZED BICYCLES,
SCOOTERS, IN-LINE SKATES, ROLLER SKATES, OR WHEELCHAIRS IN
DESIGNATED ALL-WHEEL PARKS**

Honorable Members:

Pursuant to your request on June 24, 2021, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. First, the draft ordinance amends Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 63.44.N to create a new category of all-wheel riding parks, which allow for the riding of non-motorized bicycles, scooters, in-line skates, roller skates, or wheelchairs in skate parks owned by the City of Los Angeles. Second, the draft ordinance delegates to the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) responsibility for assigning a designation (i.e., skateboarding only or all-wheel use) to all existing and future skateparks in the City. Finally, the draft ordinance amends LAMC Section 63.44.N to include, within its scope, skateparks on property owned by the City even if those skateparks are not under the control of the Board.
