

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility and cost to demolish the shade structure/ pergola and related infrastructure at the Van Nuys Civic Center located at 14410 Sylvan Street.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Martinez - O'Farrell):

1. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Engineering (BOE), with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and any other relevant departments, to report on the feasibility and cost to demolish the shade structure/ pergola and the related infrastructure that is located at the Van Nuys Civic Center at 14410 Sylvan Street adjacent to the Van Nuys Branch Library.
2. INSTRUCT the CAO, in coordination with Council District 6, the Department of Recreation and Parks, Department of Cultural Affairs, and other relevant departments, to identify alternative uses for the site, including the construction of a play structure or the installation of a public art project, and any potential funding sources.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

#### SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on November 13, 2019, the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered Motion (Martinez - O'Farrell) relative to instructing the BOE, with the assistance of the CAO and any other relevant departments, to report on the feasibility and cost to demolish the shade structure/ pergola and related infrastructure located at the Van Nuys Civic Center at 14410 Sylvan Street; and to identify alternative uses for the site and potential funding sources.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
