

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation and/or administrative action that would ensure homeowners in areas threatened by wildfires can obtain adequate homeowner's insurance without reliance on the California Fair Access to Insurance Requirements (FAIR) plan.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez - Koretz), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for legislation and/or administrative action that would ensure that homeowners in areas of California threatened by wildfires can obtain adequate homeowner's insurance without relying on the California FAIR plan, including potential legislation that would create an entity to provide fire insurance for California residents modeled after the California Earthquake Authority.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the Chief Legislative Analyst nor the City Administrative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 7, 2020, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Rodriguez - Koretz) relative to including in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program support for legislation and/or administrative action that would ensure that homeowners in areas of California threatened by wildfires can obtain adequate homeowner's insurance without relying on the California FAIR plan, including potential legislation that would create an entity to provide fire insurance for California residents modeled after the California Earthquake Authority. After providing the opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to adopt the Resolution. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
