Summary: The Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council (ASNC) extends its support to this motion (19-0002-S171) calling for advancing the impeachment inquiry into President Donald Trump as opened by House Speaker Nancy Pelosi and the U.S. House of Representatives in the investigation of actions amounting to High Crimes and Misdemeanors. The President of the United States is widely accepted as "The Leader of The Free World." It is a position of enormous power and equal responsibility. The Presidency acts as the representative of the people and role model for justice and democracy. As such the President must be held to a high standard.
