Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Wesson - Buscaino - Martinez), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for additional state funding for census activities, and SEEK AMENDMENTS that would further increase funding and ensure funding support for local outreach and education programs in the City.
