

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding SB 67 (McGuire), which would revalidate an expired temporary license if the licensee applied for an annual state license before the temporary license's expiration.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Wesson - Harris-Dawson), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for SB 67 (McGuire) which would revalidate an expired temporary license if the licensee applied for an annual state license before the temporary license's expiration, and authorize a licensing authority to issue a provisional license to applicants with an extended temporary license.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on April 16, 2019, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Committee considered a CLA report dated April 15, 2019 and Resolution (Wesson - Harris Dawson) relative to the City's position to support SB 67 (McGuire) which would revalidate an expired temporary license if the licensee applied for an annual state license before the temporary license's expiration, and authorize a licensing authority to issue a provisional license to applicants with an extended temporary license.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
