

**CORRECTED COMMITTEE REPORT**

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation which would add persons experiencing homelessness to the list of those protected by the State's hate crime law.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (RODRIGUEZ - HUIZAR), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT and/or SPONSORSHIP of legislation which would add persons experiencing homelessness to the list of those protected by California's hate crime law.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on November 16, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Rodriguez - Huizar) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation which would add persons experiencing homelessness to the list of those protected by California's hate crime law. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
