

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of North Beverly Glen Boulevard.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz - Harris-Dawson):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during all hours of the day along the west side of North Beverly Glen Boulevard from Angelo Drive to Windtree Drive.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles on the street listed above with the specific hours detailed above.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this action.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On January 15, 2019, Council considered Resolution (Koretz - Harris-Dawson) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along a segment of North Beverly Glen Boulevard. Resolution states a residential segment of North Beverly Glen Boulevard is experiencing an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking during all hours of the day, constricting travel lanes and blocking the safe exit and entrance to driveways, thereby creating a dangerous situation. Resolution recommends that parking restrictions be established along this street segment. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held January 23, 2019, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve Resolution establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along the street segment described above.
