

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along several street segments in West Los Angeles.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz – Buscaino):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along Patricia Avenue between Pico Boulevard and Lorenzo Drive, Butterfield Road between Patricia and Manning Avenues, Draper Avenue between Butterfield Road and Patricia Avenue, Troon Avenue between Butterfield Road and Patricia Avenue, and Aiken Avenue between Butterfield Road and Cushdon Drive.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles within the specific hours detailed.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

### SUMMARY

On August 16, 2019, Council considered Resolution (Koretz – Buscaino) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along several street segments in West Los Angeles. Resolution states there is an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking along this street segment overnight, blocking residents from safely exiting their homes, and constricting travel lanes, thereby creating dangerous situations. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held August 28, 2019, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council the proposed parking restrictions and related LADOT instructions pursuant to Resolution.
