

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of De Celis Place, Gault Street, and Gerald Avenue.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Martinez – Price):

1. RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 and California Vehicle Code Section 22507, to hereby prohibit the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 22 feet in length or over seven feet in height, during the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., along De Celis Place between Gault Street and Sherman Way, Gault Street between De Celis Place and Gerald Avenue, and Gerald Avenue between the cul-de-sacs to the north and south of Gault Street.
2. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), upon approval of this action, to post signs giving notice of a Tow Away, No Parking restriction for oversize vehicles within the specific hours detailed.
3. AUTHORIZE the LADOT to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On August 20, 2019, Council considered Resolution (Martinez – Price) relative to establishing oversize vehicle parking restrictions along segments of De Celis Place, Gault Street, and Gerald Avenue. Resolution states there is an increased problem with oversized vehicles parking along these street segments overnight, constricting travel lanes and creating dangerous situations. Council referred Resolution to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held August 28, 2019, the Transportation Committee considered the proposed parking restrictions. During the public comment period, a member of the community expressed support for the Resolution, stating overnight parking of oversized vehicles has detrimentally impacted the neighborhood. Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed parking restrictions and related LADOT instructions pursuant to Resolution.
