

## MOTION PUBLIC WORKS & GANG REDUCTION

In 2006, Council approved a Master Cooperative Agreement for the design/build method of project delivery for design and construction of rail and busway transit projects between the City and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) (C.F. 06-2445-S1). As part of the agreement, the City agreed to provide expedited reviews and approvals in connection with design, property acquisition, and other authority to be exercised by the City for Metro's transit projects through a Special Permitting Process.

As part of Metro's Regional Connector Transit Corridor (RCC) project, street improvements are proposed for Flower Street and includes the in-kind replacement of several pre-existing non-standard elements including decorative sidewalk tiles, travertine pavers, granite pavers, terrazzo flooring, and pull box covers with pavers. The former Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) completed these streetscape improvements as part of the City Center Redevelopment Plan along Flower Street, which included non-standard elements the public right-of-way. Although revocable permits are required for the installation of such non-standard elements, for most of these existing improvements, revocable permits do not exist.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council AUTHORIZE the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Engineering, to exempt the revocable permit requirements for the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to replace in-kind the pre-existing non-standard elements installed by the former Community Redevelopment Agency along Flower Street within the public right-of-way for the Regional Connector Transit Corridor project at the locations below:
