PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to providing a salary for the new non-represented class of Director of Automated People Mover Systems (Class Code 7266).

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated February 21, 2019 to amend Schedule A of Section 4.61 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to include and provide a salary for the new, non-represented class of Director of Automated People Mover Systems (Class Code 7266).
- 2. AUTHORIZE the City Administrative Officer (CAO), upon accretion of said class to a bargaining unit, to amend the appropriate Memorandum of Understanding to reflect the salary approved by Ordinance.
- 3. AUTHORIZE the CAO and the Controller to correct any clerical errors or technical errors in the Ordinance.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that this position is exclusive to the Los Angeles World Airports and the associated cost will not impact the General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On March 20, 2019, your Committee considered March 7, 2019 CAO and March 1, 2019 City Attorney reports and Ordinance relative to providing a salary for the new non-represented class of Director of Automated People Mover Systems (Class Code 7266). According to the CAO, on November 29, 2018, the Board of Civil Service Commissioners approved the creation of the new classification of Director of Automated People Mover Systems. Subsequently, on February 8, 2019, the Executive Employee Relations Committee approved the recommendations of the CAO to establish the salary for the new class as Salary Range 8047 with a pay range of \$168,021 to \$245,653. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the salary range as detailed in the above recommendations. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
