


MOTION

In accordance with State Law, the City Clerk is compiling petitions to establish the Highland Park Property Business Improvement District (HPBID). The HPBID would serve the community by providing such services as corridor clean up, graffiti removal, security, landscaping, and beautification. The boundaries of the proposed HPBID include both privately-owned parcels and City-owned parcels. If the City-owned parcels are included, the 50 percent threshold requirement for formation of the BID would be met.

The City has previously supported BID formation efforts in areas where the City owns property. It is critical that the HPBID formation process be expedited in order to meet upcoming deadlines related to County Assessor's tax rolls. To allow these efforts to proceed, the Council should instruct the City Clerk to sign the petition for the City-owned parcels included in the proposed HPBID.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Clerk, or designee, to sign the petition for the City-owned parcels included in the Highland Park Business Improvement District in order to meet applicable deadlines under the provision of State Law.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any changes or adjustments to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
