

MOTION

In April 2019, the Los Angeles Police Department's Southeast Division is organizing a community carnival near South Broadway and West Manchester Avenue in South Los Angeles. The purpose of the carnival is to raise funding for the Police Activities League which is a youth crime prevention program that relies on educational, athletic and other recreational activities to strengthen the relationship between police officers and the youth in the community.

Helm & Sons Amusements Incorporated, the vendor selected for the carnival, is in need of temporary storage space to accommodate carnival rides and equipment from April 8-11, 2019. The City of Los Angeles (City) owns vacant real property located at 10930 S. Clovis Avenue (A.P.N. 6071-021-915) that is suitable for temporary storage space. Council action is needed to authorize the Economic and Workforce Development Department to negotiate and execute a Right of Entry Agreement with Helm & Sons Amusements Incorporated for temporary access to the City-owned property for the term indicated above.



Clovis Avenue, Los Angeles (A.P.N. 6071-021-915), for the term of April 8 - 11, 2019, and for the purpose of accommodating the storage of carnival rides and equipment associated with a Los Angeles Police Department fundraising event.
