
ORDINANCE NO.	

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 96,753, establishing a building line.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOLWS:

Section _. Ordinance 96,753; entitled-----"An Ordinance ordering the establishment of a building line on both sides of ROSCOE BOULEVARD between Tuxford Street and Fallbrook Avenue... was passed by the Council of the City of Los Angeles at its meeting of July 19, 1950," is hereby amended by <u>repealing</u> the provisions establishing the building line on that portion of ROSCOE BOUELVARD, as depicted on the following diagram:



Sec. XX. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by positing for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

Pursuant to Section 558 of the City Charter, the Los Angeles City Planning Commission on **March 21, 2019** recommends this ordinance **BE ADOPTED** by the City Council.
