

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a lease or license agreement with the Watts Labor Community Action Committee (WLCAC) to use space at the Southwestern Multi-Purpose Senior Center located at 5133 South Crenshaw Boulevard.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Harris-Dawson - Buscaino):

INSTRUCT the Department of General Services (GSD), with the assistance of the Department of Aging (Aging), to negotiate and execute a lease or license agreement with the WLCAC, a nonprofit organization, to use space at the Southwestern Multi-Purpose Senior Center located at 5133 South Crenshaw Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90043 in Council District 8 to provide senior programs in accordance with their service contract with Aging.
