

CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the inclusion of Grand Central Market, located at 315-323 South Broadway and 312-310 South Hill Street, in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. DETERMINE that this action is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to Article 19, Section 15308, Class 8 and Article 19, Section 15331, Class 31 of the State CEQA Guidelines.
2. DETERMINE that the property conforms with the definition of a Monument pursuant to Section 22.171.7 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code.
3. ADOPT the findings of the Cultural Heritage Commission (CHC), and include the Grand Central Market, located at 315-323 South Broadway and 312-310 South Hill Street, in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments.
