

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to executing two proposed Personal Services Contracts with Rehrig Pacific Company and IPL Plastics Inc., for automated containers and ancillary services.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Board of Public Works, on behalf of the Bureau of Sanitation to execute two proposed Personal Services Contracts with Rehrig Pacific Company and IPL Plastics Inc. for the supply of automated containers and ancillary services for a term of ten years with one five-year renewal option at a cost not to exceed \$304,819,134.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is no fiscal impact as no additional General Fund appropriation is required. The 2018-19 Budget provides sufficient General Funds and special funds for the first year costs of this contract. Funding for subsequent years of this contract will be provided through the City's annual budget process, which is subject to Mayor and Council approval. Therefore, the recommendation in this report complies with City Financial Policies in that sufficient funding is available for the first year costs of this contract.
