

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to lower cost options to repair sidewalks to prevent trip-and-fall liability.

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE the Bureau of Street Services (BSS) report dated February 12, 2020 relative to lower cost options to repair sidewalks to prevent trip-and-fall liability, including options that may not meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements but would allow the City to perform more repairs.
