



MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the Homelessness and Poverty Committee’s Report relative to the Chicago Homeless Prevention and New York City’s HomeBase Programs and the plan on implementing a prevention program in the City, Item No. 15 on today’s Council Agenda (C.F.: 19-0721), BE AMENDED to:


- 1. ADOPT the following Recommendation in lieu of Recommendation 1.a. in the Report:
 - 1.a. Issue a Request for Interest to operators of FamilySource Centers to determine the centers best suited to implement Phase I of the Program;
- 2. APPROPRIATE \$1 million in the “Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority Program Expenses” line item in the Unappropriated Balance Fund No. 100-58 to the Housing and Community Investment Department Fund No. 100-43, Account 003040 (Contractual Services) to implement Phase I of the Citywide Homelessness Prevention Program; and
- 3. AUTHORIZE Housing and Community Investment Department to make any corrections, clarifications, or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections/clarifications/changes may be made orally, electronically, or by any other means.


