Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo - Rodriguez):

Public Library (LAPL), Department on Disability (DOD), Economic and Workforce Development  
Department (EWDD), and Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP), to report on  
how the City could raise awareness of and disseminate information on the availability of low- cost  
internet plans to disadvantaged and low-income communities.

has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on October 23, 2019, the Information, Technology, and General
