

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a license agreement with LCCP Blackwelder Fee Owner, LLC, (LCCP) granting LCCP limited use rights to install and monitor groundwater wells on property located at 3251 South La Cienega.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of General Services to negotiate and execute a license agreement with LCCP granting LCCP limited use rights to install and monitor groundwater wells on City property, located at 3251 South La Cienega Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90016, for a term of two years and a rental rate of \$0.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Municipal Facilities Committee reports that there is no impact to the General Fund as a result of the recommended action.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY


At its regular meeting held on August 14, 2019, the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered a MFC report, dated July 30, 2019, relative to authorizing the GSD to negotiate and execute a license agreement with LCCP, granting LCCP limited use rights to install and monitor groundwater wells on property located at 3251 South La Cienega.

During the discussion, staff from the GSD made a correction for the record related to language on the MFC report, which states that the property was sold back in April 2018. The clarification made by staff was that the property (3251 South La Cienega) has not been sold and a corrected version of the report was submitted and is attached to the Council file.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the MFC report, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
