

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the non-monetary donation of 10,008 Naloxone Kits valued at \$750,000 from the State of California Health and Human Services Agency.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the non-monetary donation of 10,008 Naloxone Kits valued at \$750,000 from the State of California Health and Human Services Agency, Naloxone Distribution Project to be utilized by the Los Angeles Police Department's first responders.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


Summary:

On August 28, 2019, your Committee considered a July 16, 2019 Board of Police Commissioners (BPC) report relative to the non-monetary donation of 10,008 Naloxone Kits valued at \$750,000 from the State of California Health and Human Services Agency, Naloxone Distribution Project to be utilized by the Los Angeles Police Department's first responders. According to the BPC, this donation is for the benefit of the LAPD. The solicited donation of 10,008 naloxone kits will be utilized by the LAPD's first responders to render lifesaving aide when an individual is experiencing an opioid overdose. From May 2018 through December 2018, the LAPD successfully launched a citywide Naloxone pilot program designed to train and equip LAPD Officers. No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend accepting the donation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
