The Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) desires to authorize its Chief Executive Officer to use alternative project delivery methods and the competitive sealed proposal selection process for the Bus Yard Facility Relocation Project and related capital improvement projects at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) consistent with City Charter Sections 371 and 375. This Office has prepared and now transmits for your approval the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, which would accomplish BOAC's goal.
