

PERSONNEL AND ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to the establishment of salary for the new, non-represented classification of City Forest Officer.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE dated August 14, 2019 amending Schedule A of Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) Section 4.61 to include and provide a salary for the new, non-represented classification of City Forest Officer (Class Code 3136).
2. AUTHORIZE the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Controller to correct any clerical errors, or, if approved by the City Attorney, and technical errors in the Ordinance.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that there is no additional impact upon the General Fund for Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-20. The Board of Public Works Commissioners will absorb any additional costs into its approved FY 2019-20 budget.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.


Summary:

In their respective reports dated August 23, 2019, and August 14, 2019, the CAO and City Attorney recommend approval of the accompanying Ordinance amending Schedule A of LACC Section 4.61 to include and provide a salary for the new, non-represented classification of City Forest Officer (Class Code 3136). According to the CAO, on April 25, 2019, the Board of Civil Service Commissioners approved the creation of the new classification of City Forest Officer. The Executive Employee Relations Committee approved salary ranges at its July 2, 2019, meeting as follows: City Forest Officer (Code 3136), Salary Range 5736. This classification serves under direction of the Board of Public Works.

At its special meeting held August 28, 2019, the Personnel and Animal Welfare Committee recommended that Council approve the accompanying Ordinance and related action, as recommended by the CAO.
