

MOTION

Maclay Street just north of the I-210 freeway is comprised of two lanes in each direction, except at a small one-block segment between Gladstone and Hunnewell Avenues adjacent to an unimproved lot. The sudden narrowing of the roadway at this location is causing excessive peak-hour traffic congestion. The lack of a sidewalk on this side of the street is also problematic in that it causes pedestrians to walk in the narrow vehicular lane of traffic.

The Bureau of Engineering and the Department of Transportation have prepared a conceptual design for a roadway improvement project at this location that includes concrete improvements, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, and signal/signage/stripping work.


I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council designate the Bureau of Engineering as the project manager, with support from the Department of Transportation, for the design and construction of the Maclay Street at Gladstone Avenue Street Improvement project.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council instruct the Bureau of Engineering to:

1. Commence the preliminary design of the project, including traffic signal synchronization to address traffic congestion;
2. Begin negotiations with the affected property owner to obtain the necessary easements to allow construction of the project;
3. Coordinate with the Department of Water and Power and the Foothill Trunk Line Replacement Project; and
4. Submit a FY2020-21 budget request for the final design and construction of the project.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Administrative Officer be instructed to report with funding options to construct the project.
