The Silver Lake Neighborhood Council requests that the following Community Impact Statement be added to Council File 19-1205 regarding vaping.

COMMUNITY IMPACT STATEMENT

The Silver Lake Neighborhood Council support providing general comments for the vaping proposal because the threat to public health associated with vaping is real. Furthermore, the City should move to prohibit the sale of all nicotine-based vaping products and associated accessories used for vaping within the City of Los Angeles for one year and should continue until vaping has been determined safe for consumer use by the Federal Drug Administration (FDA).

The Community Impact Statement is based on the action taken at the regularly scheduled Governing Board meeting on January 8, 2020, when the Silver Lake Neighborhood Council adopted the following motion by a vote of 12 yes, 0 no, 5 abstaining and directed that a Community Impact statement be filed reflecting this position.

Motion: The Silver Lake Neighborhood Council urges that, in response to the public health threat posed by vaping devices and the rapid onset of lethal lung disease caused by vaping, that the City Attorney draft an ordinance that will prohibit the sale of all e-cigarettes and nicotine-based vaping devices until such devices are determined to be safe by the FDA.
