Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety with the assistance of the Department of City Planning, Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Department of Transportation, and the Los Angeles Fire Department and any other relevant departments, to report with an overview and status update of BuildLA including the following:

- a. How various departments are participating in the platform.
- b. The tools that are currently available to users, and what future tools will be added to the system to make it easier for applicants to track their applications.
- c. A timeline for the complete implementation of BuildLA as envisioned as a universal online portal for development projects.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on November 13, 2019, the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered Motion (Rodriguez - Blumenfield) relative to instructing the LADBS, with the assistance of other relevant departments, to report with an overview and status update of BuildLA, including participation by departments in the platform, current and new tools for applicants to track their applications, and a timeline for the complete implementation of BuildLA as a universal online portal for development projects.
