MOTION

The Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) is coordinating the implementation of a comprehensive parking and pedestrian wayfinding sign program in the Hollywood Entertainment Core as part of the Hollywood Integrated Modal Information System (HIMIS) project. As part of the 2007 Call for Projects, the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority's (LACMTA) awarded grant funds to Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) to implement HIMIS. As a result of the dissolution of the CRA, in 2014, LACMTA and City Council transferred the project to LADOT to implement.

In support of HIMIS's intent to implement a comprehensive pedestrian wayfinding sign program in Hollywood's Entertainment Core, Council District 13 previously contributed funding (CF 18-0011-S14) to install signs south of the HIMIS project area. In support of this same effort to benefit pedestrians in the area, LACMTA proposed the one-time transfer of funds from its Hollywood/Highland Red Line Station Wayfinding Signage Improvements project to LADOT via a Grant Agreement to fund the installation of seven wayfinding signs north of the HIMIS project area.


Under the terms of the Agreement, LACMTA will provide \$34,461 to LADOT on a reimbursement basis and LADOT will provide \$1,815 as a 5 percent local match for the installation of signs north of the HIMIS area. LADOT will provide the match from the City's Special Parking Revenue Fund.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor:

1. Authorize the General Manager of LADOT to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with the LACMTA to design, construct, and install the wayfinding signs, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, and
2. Appropriate within Transportation Grant Fund No 655/94, \$34,461 to a new account entitled "Way Finding Program North of HIMIS", and
3. Authorize LADOT to invoice and receive a sum of up to \$34,461 from LACMTA as reimbursement for way finding program north of HIMIS.

I FURTHER MOVE that LADOT be authorized to make any technical correction or clarification to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
