

HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to applying for and accepting Lead Hazard Reduction Program funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Cedillo - Harris-Dawson), and SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA), or designee, to:
 - a. Apply for the Lead Hazard Reduction Program funding from HUD.
 - b. Accept the Lead Hazard Reduction Program grants totaling \$5.6 million, and execute any and all documents to reflect acceptance of this grant, consistent with the form of the sample agreement attached to the Council file.
2. INSTRUCT HCIDLA to report and present the grant agreements and provide details on program design, staffing needs, Controller's instructions, and other relevant information for review and approval.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a regular meeting held on November 13, 2019, the Housing Committee considered a Motion (Cedillo - Harris-Dawson) relative to authorizing the General Manager, HCIDLA, or designee, to apply for Lead Hazard Reduction Program funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), accept the Lead Hazard Reduction Program grants totaling \$5.6 million, execute any and all documents to reflect acceptance of this grant, and report with the grant agreements and program details. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended approving the Motion as amended. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
