

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a funding request from the State's Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention Program (HHAPP) grant to develop a Safe Parking program on a City owned parking lot located at 19610 Hamilton Avenue.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino - Harris-Dawson):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to submit to the Homeless Strategy Committee a request of approximately \$219,000 from the State's pending HHAPP grant to develop a Safe Parking program on a City owned parking lot at 19610 Hamilton Avenue, in the Harbor Gateway community of Council District 15, and that the program include the services as detailed in this Motion.
2. INSTRUCT the CAO to report to Council with an alternative funding source(s), if the site is not funded by the HHAPP at the time grant funding is committed.
3. REQUEST Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to add the 19610 Hamilton Avenue site owned by the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles in its next Safe Parking Request For Proposals, use the City funds identified in this Motion, or any other funds that become available to finance the project, be authorized to sole source a contract for the site if no qualified proposals are received, and report to Council on the results of the Request for Proposals.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on January 15, 2020, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Buscaino - Harris-Dawson) relative to a funding request from the State's HHAPP grant to develop a Safe Parking program on a City owned parking lot located at 19610 Hamilton Avenue. After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the recommendations in the Motion as reflected above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
