

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the shifting of funds in the Homeless Housing, Assistance, and Prevention Program (HHAPP), Category 6 Youth Experiencing Homelessness or At Risk of Homelessness.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to (Bonin - Harris-Dawson):

1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to reprogram categories in their next report to Council with recommendations on the HHAPP funding categories to shift at least \$8,786,215 in additional funds to Category 6 Youth Experiencing Homelessness or At Risk of Homelessness. This represents the 16 percent of the total HHAPP funds allocated to the City..
2. INSTRUCT the CAO and CLA to adjust HHAPP categories of funding as needed going forward to ensure that Category 6 Youth Experiencing Homelessness or At Risk of Homelessness continues to receive no less than 16 percent of the total HHAPP funds in the City in 2020.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on January 15, 2020, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Bonin - Harris-Dawson) relative to the funds in the HHAPP, Category 6 Youth Experiencing Homelessness or At Risk of Homelessness.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee approved the recommendations in the Motion as reflected above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
