

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the identification of funds to provide temporary shelter and services for individuals facing homelessness in the Skid Row area of downtown Los Angeles.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Huizar - Harris-Dawson - O'Farrell - Price):

INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and REQUEST the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority to identify \$14 million in funding to provide temporary shelter and services for individuals facing homelessness throughout the Skid Row area of downtown Los Angeles.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:


