Summary: City of Los Angeles' employees need to know their pension funds are safe, and aren't making climate change worse. LA residents shouldn't have to rescue a pension fund because of failing investments in a declining industry. Wilshire Center Koreatown Neighborhood Council supports 19-1577, which requests that the LA City Employees Retirement System's board report on the feasibility of a phased divestment of risky assets as stated in Council File 19-1577 is implemented. Climate change is increasing risks of fire, coastal flooding, and hurricanes. Some insurers have been warning public policy leaders and the general public about the threat of global warming for years. Many pension funds are still exposed to financial risk from climate change. Fossil fuel company stocks are losing value. Insurance and finance companies are reducing their exposure to these risks. Divesting from these failing industries could improve the financial health of LA City Employees pension plan - Therefore be it resolved, Wilshire Center Koreatown Neighborhood Council SUPPORTS the motion to create a plan to divest LACERS investments from fossil fuels.
