

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY REPORT relative to a funding request for a Work to Succeed weed abatement employment pilot program using the State's Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention Program (HHAPP) grant.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Lee - O'Farrell):

INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to submit to the Homeless Strategy Committee for review a funding request in the amount of \$510,000 using the State's HHAPP grant (City Proposed Category 3 - Prevention, Shelter, Diversion to Permanent Housing, and Bridge Housing Operations) for a one-year weed abatement employment program for homeless individuals to be operated by the West Valley Alliance in Council District 12.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on January 15, 2020, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Lee - O'Farrell) relative to a start-up funding request by the West Valley Alliance for a Work to Succeed weed abatement employment pilot program using the State's HHAPP grant.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
