

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation or administrative action to provide additional funding for a pilot program for counseling and coordinated delivery of services to aid Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) students and families experiencing homelessness.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Buscaino - Martinez - Ryu), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for additional funding for a pilot program to provide counseling and coordinated delivery of services to aid LAUSD students and families experiencing homelessness.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on February 21, 2020, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered the CLA report and Resolution (Buscaino - Martinez - Ryu) relative to including in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program support for additional funding for a pilot program that would provide counseling and coordinated delivery of services to aid LAUSD students and families experiencing homelessness. After providing the opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that the Council adopt the CLA report and Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
