

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding SB 970 (Umberg) which would change the date of the statewide direct primary election to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June in even-numbered years in which there is no presidential primary.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution, SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2019-20 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT SB 970 (Umberg) which would change the date of the statewide direct primary election to the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June in even-numbered years in which there is no presidential primary.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the Chief Legislative Analyst nor the City Administrative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY
