

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the request to make an amendment to the City Election Code to maintain a March Primary and a November General Election for those years in which a Presidential Primary Election is conducted, as well as to change to a June Primary and a November Run-Off Election for those years in which a Gubernatorial Primary Election is conducted.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST the City Attorney to draft an ordinance to make an amendment to the City Election Code to maintain a March Primary and a November General Election for those years in which a Presidential Primary Election is conducted, as well as to change to a June Primary and a November Run-Off Election for those years in which a Gubernatorial Primary Election is conducted.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Clerk reports that the approval of the revised City Election Code and change in election preparation dates will have no impact on the City's General Fund.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on February 16, 2021, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a City Clerk report relative to the request to make an amendment to the City Election Code to maintain a March Primary and a November General Election for those years in which a Presidential Primary Election is conducted, as well as to change to a June Primary and a November Run-Off Election for those years in which a Gubernatorial Primary Election is conducted. The report attached to the file, includes background information about the matter. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This mater is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
