- 3) The RVNC urges the LA City Council to pass a resolution echoing our own condemnations; and
- 4) The RVNC urges the Mayor and LA City Council to examine procurement processes by the city that include the purchase of Turkish and Azerbaijan goods & services, should they exist, and to utilize alternate sources for those goods & services.
