Please be advised that at a regular public meeting of the Venice Neighborhood Council (VNC) Board of Officers held on June 15, 2021, the following Motion was approved.

MOTION:

In March, 2020, in an attempt to slow the spread of COVID19, the Los Angeles City Council voted for a partial suspension of city law L.A.M.C 56.11 which requires tents to be broken down during the daytime. COVID19 restrictions are being lifted across the City, and Governor Newsom has issued an order regarding COVID19 guidelines effective June 15, 2021, removing all capacity limits and physical distancing requirements imposed because of COVID19, regardless of setting. The Venice Neighborhood Council recommends the full restoration and enforcement of LAMC 56.11 Upon passage of this Resolution, a CIS will be filed to CF 20-0147 and
