

MOTION

On July 29, 2020, the City Council adopted motion (Buscaino-Krekorian, CF 20-0147), and instructed LA Sanitation and Environment (LASAN) to resume CARE+ Comprehensive cleaning in A Bridge Home (ABH) Special Enforcement Cleaning Zones (SECZ) only.

A dangerous illegal structure in Council District 5, outside of ABH SECZs, has gone months without being rectified. This illegal structure blocks the city right of way and creates a life-threatening danger to the neighborhood and surrounding homes.

In fact, the first time the structure was erected, a large fire from within it nearly burned adjacent buildings due to its size and intensity. The fire caused damage to the sidewalk, neighboring building walls, and an enormous amount of burned trash and debris was left obstructing the entire public right of way. There is now a new structure and as of yesterday 1/26/2021 a second wooden structure is being built blocking the public right away and presenting an imminent danger to life and limb for all those who reside nearby.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Fire Department be directed to investigate the hazards presented by the illegal structure located at 130 N Croft Ave in Council District 5 and that the Council Action of March 17, 2020 (CF# 20-0147, as amended by motion 72-P and motion 72-P-A), relative to suspending comprehensive CARE+ cleanups, be AMENDED to AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Sanitation to resume CARE+ cleanups and remove this illegal structure.
