

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the monetary donation of \$40,000 to be used to fund a variety of Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) events aimed at maintaining working relationships between the LAPD and community members.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the monetary donation of \$40,000 to be used to fund a variety of LAPD events aimed at creating and maintaining working relationships between the LAPD and community members.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On February 26, 2020, your Committee considered a December 17, 2019 Board report relative to the monetary donation of \$40,000 to be used to fund a variety of Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) events aimed at maintaining working relationships between the LAPD and community members. According to the Board, the LAPD Morale and Well-Being Grant would benefit the 13,000 sworn and civilian personnel. The grant would boost LAPD morale and serve as a motivator for employees to continue to give their very best to the City and community they protect and serve. The grant will provide funding for a variety of LAPD events which will continue efforts aimed at maintaining working relationships and foster new relationships between the LAPD and community members. If approved, reimbursements for the proposed expenditures will be submitted to the Los Angeles Police Foundation along with vendor information and itemized receipts. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of accepting the donation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
