REVISED NOTICE TO INTERESTED PARTIES

You are hereby notified that the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee of the Los Angeles City Council will hold a public hearing **telephonically** on **Tuesday, December 7, 2021**, at approximately **2:00 P.M.**, or soon thereafter, to consider the following:

Consideration of rescission of the City Council's prior action taken on June 29, 2021 (Council file No. 20-0246; Case No. CHC-2019-6975-HCM), in which the City Council adopted the Finding of the PLUM Committee as the Finding of Council, and disapproved the recommendation of the Cultural Heritage Commission (CHC), thereby denying the application for the inclusion of the Chili Bowl in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments.

Consideration of a Categorical Exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Article 19, Section 15308, Class 8, and Article 19, Section 15331, Class 31 of the State CEQA Guidelines, and a report from the CHC relative to the inclusion of the Chili Bowl, located at 12244-12248 West Pico Boulevard, in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments.

The Committee may recess to Closed Session, pursuant to Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1), to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, its legal counsel regarding pending litigation relative to the case entitled Los Angeles Conservancy v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCP02696. **(This matter arises from an alleged Ralph M. Brown Act violation during the June 15, 2021 PLUM Committee meeting, and is related to the Petitioner's application proposing that the property located at 12244 West Pico Boulevard, known as the Chili Bowl, be designated as a Historic-Cultural Monument.)**

Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361, and due to concerns over COVID-19, this Los Angeles City Council committee meeting will take all public comment by teleconference.

The time in which you may seek judicial review of any final action by the City Council is limited by California Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6 which provides that an action pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.5 challenging the Council's action must be filed no later than the 90th day following the date on which the Council action becomes final.
